

# Community Puzzles

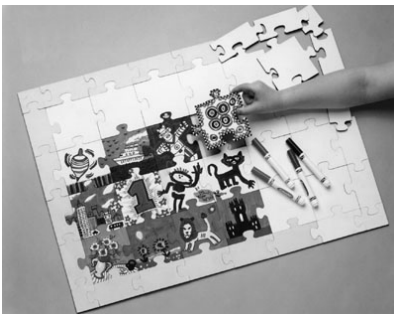


- Are you looking for a new resource to get your children more involved in the classroom?
- Do you need a different way of getting ideas together about a theme?
- Do you want a cost-effective activity that everyone can take part in?

Community Puzzles are now available in Britain! They consist of large blank puzzle pieces that fit together in any order. Each person decorates a piece and adds it to the community collage. Any size group can participate. All you need to do is to choose a theme and have enough pieces for everyone. The largest puzzle created so far included over 10,000 pieces

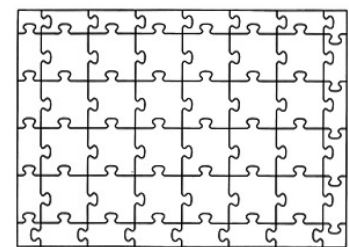


They can be used in a classroom setting to gather ideas on a theme, to illustrate a topic that is being studied or to mark an event. They can help draw out thoughts for sharing, review feelings or generate ideas. If the school as a whole wants to mark an anniversary, a new building or a seasonal occurrence then puzzle pieces can be brought together from different classes to make a visually stunning display. They can even be used as fundraiser with the right to decorate a piece being sold for a small sum.



Each person in the group uses felt pens, crayons or coloured pencils to decorate a puzzle piece and adds it to the community collage. The extra thick board pieces can even be built on for a three dimensional patchwork quilt effect.

The pieces are designed to be universal in size and shape, so the puzzle is easy to assemble, fits together in any order and is expandable for any size group. A standard puzzle is 48 pieces and when completed measures 51 x 72 cm, however you can add as many pieces together as you require, making puzzles of several metres across.



Once completed, for a permanent display, puzzles can be glued onto MDF or plywood and can even be framed.
